Most brand name and generic prescription drugs are included in the Bankers Health Advantage program.

A small number of prescribed medicines may not be eligible for discounts, so check with your participating pharmacist.

Two Ways To Fill Your Prescription and Save 5% To 30%

1. Retail Pharmacy

Give your prescription and your Bankers Health Advantage membership card to the pharmacist, who will check to see that you are an active member and will fill your prescription. With more than 27,000 participating retail pharmacies, including both national chains and independent retailers, you are sure to find one conveniently located.

Your pharmacist will enter your unique Rx number into the computer system to verify that you are an active Bankers Health Advantage member.

If the pharmacist has any questions or is unfamiliar with the pharmacy network system, he or she should call the Pharmacist Help Desk, toll-free. The number is shown on the back of the membership card. Note that some prescriptions require prior authorization. If this is the case, the pharmacist or your doctor should call the Pharmacist Help Desk, toll-free, for instructions.

2. Mail Service Pharmacy

When you need to take medications over an extended period of time, greater discounts may be available from the mail service pharmacy.

Ask your doctor to write a prescription for a 90-day supply, plus appropriate refills for up to one year. If you need to begin the medicine immediately, ask your doctor for a second prescription for a 30-day supply and fill that at your participating retail pharmacy.

To begin mail service, complete the member profile / mailer provided in your membership

kit. You only need to complete the profile once. Be sure to include the Rx Number from your card and seal your prescription in the envelope. If you need order forms, call the toll-free Member Services number.

The Mail Service Pharmacy will ship your medication within 48 hours of receipt, free of shipping costs. You should receive it within two weeks by mail with standard delivery. Overnight or second-day delivery may be available in your area for an additional charge.

Know With Certainty Your Medications Are Safe

The quality assurance program helps to identify potential problems with your medications. When you use a participating retail pharmacy, the mail service pharmacy or the online pharmacy, your prescription is entered into a computer. If you should avoid certain drugs, a message on the computer screen alerts the pharmacist. The pharmacist also receives messages if it appears you are using certain drugs too often or not often enough, and if an adverse reaction is possible because of other drugs you are taking.
